

OurStage Drake 'Thank Me Later' Backstage Correspondent Competition Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED. OPEN ONLY TO OURSTAGE ACCOUNT-HOLDERS WHO ARE EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** Open to OurStage account-holders, who have internet access and are eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of entry. Entrants must be legal residents of the fifty (50) United States, the District of Columbia or Canada.

The following are not eligible: employees, contractors, directors and officers of Sponsor organizations set forth in Section 12 (collectively "Sponsors"), and each of their respective parent, subsidiaries and affiliated companies, distributors, web design, advertising, fulfillment, judging and Contest agencies involved in the administration, development, fulfillment and execution of this Contest (collectively, "Contest Parties"), and the immediate family members of each (spouse, parent, child, sibling, grandparent, and spouse or "step" of each) and those living in their same households (those persons whether related or not who live in the same residence for at least three months during the twelve-month period preceding the start date of the Contest).

To enter, Entry may be uploaded between 12:00 am EST July 1, 2010 and 11:59:59 pm EST July 22, 2010 ("Submission Period").

- Entrants must completely fill out a profile and their OurStage Profile including a headshot and bio.

- No Entries will be returned. Contest Parties may, in their sole discretion, remove, delete and/or disqualify Entries deemed to be inappropriate or otherwise non-compliant.
- If any group of individuals elects to collaborate on an Entry, they are required to designate one (1) person as the agent of the group to enter the Contest, agree to these rules and accept the prize on behalf of the group. - 7. SELECTION OF WINNER:** There are two (2) rounds of voting to determine the Winner for the Drake 'Thank Me Later' Backstage Correspondent Competition.

Regular Judging: All eligible Entries will be posted on the Web Site. There will be a public vote online ("Judging") to determine the top thirty (30) Entries from the Drake 'Thank Me Later' Backstage Correspondent Competition starting on July 1, 2010 at 12:00:01 am EST and ending July 24, 2010 at 12:00:01 am EST. Members of www.OurStage.com will be asked during this Judging process to rank an Entry compared to another Entry. Automated methods of voting are strictly prohibited. Only one (1) account per person/email address will be allowed to vote. Judging or entering

through multiple accounts is strictly prohibited. The top thirty (30) Entries in the Drake 'Thank Me Later' Backstage Correspondent Competition will be determined based on this Judging using proprietary ranking algorithms.

Judging Panel: The Top 30 Entries in the Drake 'Thank Me Later' Backstage Correspondent Competition will move on to the stage of the Contest, where Entries will be judged by a panel of qualified judges, who are experts in the field of music, based on the following four (4) criteria: (i) Creativity (25%); (ii) Melody and Music (25%); (iii) Lyrics (25%) and (iv) Entertainment Value (25%). In the event of a tie, the Entrants will be re-judged based on: (i) Creativity (50%) and (ii) Melody and Music (50%). The decisions of the judging panels are final and binding on all matters relating to the Contest.

On or about July 26, 2010, the Sponsors will select one (1) winner from all Entries within the Top 30 in the Drake 'Thank Me Later' Backstage Correspondent Competition. The Winner selected shall be the "Contest Grand Prize Winner".

The potential Winner will be notified by e-mail or phone and will be given instructions on how to claim prize. The potential Winner (including each band member who appears in the Entry materials and recording) will be required to sign and return an affidavit of eligibility and liability release (and, where permitted, a publicity release) within 72 hours of notification of prize or prize will be forfeited and an alternate winner will be chosen.

Entrants agree that the Sponsors have the sole right to decide all matters and disputes arising from this Contest and that all decisions of Sponsors are final and binding. Any attempt by Entrant and/or his/her family/friends to vote more than the number of times authorized using multiple names or email address and/or any other fraudulent mechanism, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, shall give Sponsors the right to disqualify Entrant in its reasonable discretion.

- The chance to become a backstage correspondent for the Drake performance at the Molson Amphitheatre on August 1, 2010.
- Winner will have VIP backstage access and will be in charge of following the winning artist and interviewing Drake and other artists on tour.
- OurStage will provide up to two thousand (\$2,000) for the prize winner to offset expenses to attend the Molson Amphitheatre in Toronto Canada.

Total ARV =\$2,000

Actual value may vary depending on Prize Winner's point of travel origin and subject to Sponsors final determination. In the event that the Prize Winner elects not to participate in any or all designated activities for the prize, he/she will not be afforded additional

compensation in exchange therefore. If a Prize Winner decides not to attend, he/she will be replaced with another Entrant decided by the Sponsors.

Additional meals, gratuities, souvenirs, incidentals, and all other expenses not specified herein are the responsibility of the Prize Winner.
